

Suitable blood / serum tubes:



Yellow topped, SST™ II Advance Vacutainer



Samples can either be sent in their original bottles un-spun as whole blood or already spun (for 10 minutes at 2,500rpm) and aliquoted as separated serum. If spun and serum aliquoted, ship (cooled or frozen at -20oC) through the post nationally in a protective mailer conforming to UN3373.

Do not freeze when sending the Vacutainers.

Serum samples are to be kept cold or frozen if being sent <u>internationally</u> by courier.

Aliquoted out into vials is the recommended choice for sample stability.

Example of protective and posting mailers:



Standard screw cap neutral, for mailing container 126 x 30mm



Mailing container, 126 x 30mm, with absorbent liner

Samples must be placed in a container with a hard outer and absorbent liner. This can be then posted to us in either a mailing box or padded envelope.

Individual mailers are not necessary if sending large numbers as long as all tubes are well protected during transport and will not cross-contaminate if leaked.

Please do not post on a Friday due to the potential for delay over the weekend.
